This included assistant coaching positions in college and the NBL. Kelly's first Head Coaching position was with the Cairns Taipans where he was awarded the NBL Coach of the Year in 2020. Kelly was appointed Head Coach of the South East Melbourne Phoenix twelve months ago.

Mike will be touching on a range of topics including shooting, defence and structuring a practice session.
